

COVID-19 EMERGENCY - GREEN CERTIFICATION

Privacy Disclaimer pursuant to art. 13 reg. EU 2016/679 (GDPR)

For reasons strictly connected to the prevention of contagion from COVID-19, as well as implementation of the regulations on access to the workplace pursuant to Legislative Decree 127/2021, **it is necessary, starting from October 15th 2021**, to verify the validity of green certification for people who, for any purpose, enter facilities where work is carried out (factories and offices).

For this reason, we inform you that the refusal to submit to this verification implies the impossibility for the person to fulfill a legal obligation and, consequently, the impossibility to access to company sites.

Pursuant to art. 13 GDPR, we inform you that:

The data controller is the company **OSAI A.S. S.p.A.**, with registered office in Turin, V. Sondrio 13 / I, operational headquarters in Parella (To), V. The processing of personal data will take place in accordance with the provisions of the law, according to principles of lawfulness, correctness and transparency, for specific purposes and with a view to "data minimization", as well as the other requirements contained in art. 5 GDPR.

The legal basis that authorizes the owner to carry out this processing is to be identified in the obligation to fulfill the legal obligations to which the owner is subject, with specific regard to the provisions of **Legislative Decree 127/2021 and the D.P.C.M. 17.6.2021**. Personal data will be processed by expressly authorized personnel.

The data contained in the green certification will not be stored, will be subjected to automated processes for the sole purpose of verification, and in any case will not be subject to profiling.

With respect to this treatment, the interested parties will be able to exercise the rights provided for by art. 15 and ss. of the GDPR within the limits and conditions provided for by the same and in particular: right of access to data, of rectification and cancellation, of limitation of treatment, as well as to oppose, for legitimate reasons, to the treatment itself.

The law also recognizes the right to lodge a complaint with the Guarantor Authority for the protection of personal data.
